



Quality Points for Grades 6-12

What is it?

Quality points convert the numerical percentage point to a point system that represents the letter grade.

What do families need to know?

Parents/guardians will see letter grades reflected on interims and report cards.

Parents can access the actual percentage earned in the Parent Portal in Focus.

A = 4 points

B = 3 points

C = 2 points

D = 1 point

F = 0 points

What are the advantages for students?

It mirrors the Grade Point Average (GPA) calculation model & the End of Year Course calculation model from the state.

It makes recovery possible for students with a low grade or average.

It is a similar calculation model across other districts.

This is not retroactive for grades earned prior to this school year.
